Image Review Tips

Describe as many elements as you can, done well, and why. If you have a comment you should have a reason. Describe as many elements as you can that need help, and why. If you have a fix for the problem say it. This is where you help the maker.

The list of the elements is to help discuss, it is up to you to formulate a constructive analysis around them and any others you may consider.

Image Critique Elements to consider

Creativity and Originality Noise and/or Grain,
Composition, line, eye movement, Lighting
Focus, depth of field, Exposure, Impact
Dimension/Perspective, Tonal range,
Image balance, Color, if any. Do the elements
within the frame feel comfortable

If these elements are present acknowledgement of that fact helps the maker to do it again. If the elements are missing it may help the maker to include it in the future.
